Proposed award of subsidised local bus service contracts

Report by Head of Bus Strategy & Delivery

1. Object of report

To recommend the Partnership approve the award of a number of subsidised local bus service and MyBus contracts.

This paper affects East Ayrshire, Glasgow, Inverclyde, North Ayrshire, North Lanarkshire, Renfrewshire, South Ayrshire and South Lanarkshire Council areas.

2. Background to report

SPT subsidises bus services which are not provided by the commercial market, but which are considered socially necessary. A proportion of these contracts are due to expire in July 2024 and tender bids have been sought for their renewal.

Prior to seeking replacement contracts SPT analyses existing provision, reviewing performance data for each specified journey within each service to align provision with actual demand. In addition, the opportunity is also taken to determine whether contracts can be amalgamated in situations where this may improve connectivity and overall sustainability.

Operators must submit compliant tenders, but optional alternative prices are also considered whereby the operator may submit an option which offers efficiency savings to SPT. It is also permissible for operators to package contracts where this may provide better value for money.

3. Outline of proposals

Of the six advertised individual local bus service and MyBus contracts, it is proposed to award all six with a total contract value of $\pounds 2,555,533$ as detailed in Appendix 1. This will result in an annual increase of $\pounds 105,595$ when compared to the current annual contract value.

The award of these contracts, as well as other contract awards and amendments since the start of the financial year will result in a provisional outturn figure of £14,563,419 against a budget of £14,267,633. Accordingly, the Network Analysis & Design team are currently preparing and assessing service reduction options in accordance with the Framework for Supporting Local Bus Services to reduce the estimated spend in line with available budget. Further details will be shared with the Operations Committee in due course.

The recent tender exercise was the third round conducted for the 2024 contract renewals and prices submitted reflected rising operational costs for bus operators and wider challenges in the local bus market. In the case of contracts 5627U, W022J and W149E, further direct negotiations were undertaken with local bus operators to seek revised and improved bids. The direct negotiation process was successful in securing improved bids for contracts W022J and W149E specifically.

In addition to the above, the Partnership is advised that contract W022H1 has been procured to replace the previous contract which will be terminated due to poor operational performance. The Partnership is also advised that this contract, for services M2 and 74, currently utilises two SPT vehicles and will now be operated from the renewal date by one SPT vehicle, maintaining connectivity within the available budget.

Copies of all timetables are available on request. Specific details of individual contracts are attached in Appendix 1, with the current cost and contract renewal cost shown.

4. Partnership action

The Partnership is recommended to agree the award of the contracts detailed in Appendix 1, noting that the award of contract W149E is subject to the approval of West Lothian Council for a continued 75% funding contribution.

5. Consequences
