Proposed award of subsidised local bus service contracts

Report by Head of Bus Strategy & Delivery

1. Object of report

To recommend the Committee approve the award of a number of subsidised local bus service and MyBus contracts.

This paper affects East Dunbartonshire, Glasgow, North Ayrshire, North Lanarkshire and South Lanarkshire council areas.

2. Background to report

SPT subsidises bus services which are not provided by the commercial market, but which are considered socially necessary. A number of these contracts are due to expire in July 2025 and tender bids have been sought for their renewal.

Prior to seeking replacement contracts SPT analyses existing provision, reviewing performance data for each specified journey within each service to align provision with actual demand. In addition, the opportunity is also taken to determine whether contracts can be amalgamated in situations where this may improve connectivity and overall sustainability.

Operators must submit compliant tenders, but optional alternative prices are also considered whereby the operator may submit an option which offers efficiency savings to SPT. It is also permissible for operators to package contracts where this may provide better value for money.

A number of contracts advertised, but not recommended for award to this committee were deemed unsustainable, therefore further round(s) of tendering, and subsequent direct negotiation is being carried out to deliver best value for the subsidised bus budget.

3. Outline of proposals

Of the 37 advertised individual local bus service and MyBus contracts, it is proposed to award 9 at this stage with a total contract value of £4,506,143 detailed in Appendix 1. This will result in an annual increase of £52,699 to the subsidised bus budget costs when compared to the current annual contract value.

The Committee is advised that the contracts for service 14 and 251 currently utilise SPT vehicles and will be operated from the renewal date with operator vehicles. Copies of all timetables are available on request. Specific details of individual contracts are attached at Appendix 1 with the current and contract renewal cost shown.

4. Committee action

The Committee is recommended to agree the award of the contracts detailed in Appendix 1.

5. Consequences
