1. Object of report

To advise the Committee of amendments to subsidised local bus service contracts since the last Committee, on 23 August 2019.

2. Background

It is necessary to adjust subsidised local bus service contracts to react to external factors, such as the fluidity of the commercial local bus network or road / traffic management issues in order to ensure as far as possible, service continuity to the travelling public. Appendix 1 details such amendments.

In addition to those contracts detailed in Appendix 1, SPT continue to adjust a number of others to align their delivery on local and national public holidays with commercial provision.

Processes continue to ensure that all subsidised local bus service contracts are monitored and reviewed on a sustainable basis, whilst meeting obligations in terms of best value, therefore ensuring that funding is used to greatest effect.

3. Committee action

The Committee is recommended to note the amendments to subsidised local bus contracts, in accordance with established corporate governance, financial regulation and standings.
